He created life	(Sura 5:113)
He healed the sick	(Sura 5:113)
He raised the dead	(Sura 5:113)
He came with clear signs	(Sura 43:63)
He is a sign to all mankind	(Sura 19:21; 21:91)
He is illustrious in this world and the hereafter	(Sura 3:45)
He was raised to heaven (where he still is)	(Sura 4:158)
He will come back for judgement	(Sura 43:61)

These are 13 true statements about Jesus Christ. Can we think of any man, who ever lived, excepting Elijah perhaps, that could truthfully claim just 3 of these for himself? This evidence alone makes Jesus more than a prophet. These qualities clearly give Him a divine status.
